

Aboriginal Communities and Domestic Violence predicated by SAPOL

I make the following Submission to the Royal Commission.

It is in relation to Family Violence and Domestic Violence within Aboriginal Communities.

SAPOL have been issuing in Aboriginal Communities, Police Issued Interim Intervention Orders since 2011.

They have been unlawful as they did not comply with the Intervention Orders (Prevention of Abuse) Act 2009.

They were therefore all 'void ab initio'.

South Australian Police have been issuing thousands of these Orders in the Aboriginal Communities of;

- Amata,
- Freegon,
- Indulkna,
- Mimili,
- Yalata,
- Ernabella,
- Pipalyata

SAPOL have created since 2011, a “SAPOL Stolen Generation”

SAPOL Officers have been handing them out like confetti.

The evidence of this exists in SAPOL Commissioner Briefing Papers reference; PCO 2007/3987 (various dates with same number).

The problem that exists is that it creates friction, angst and ill-will among Aboriginal Communities.

There is near no if any, referral by SAPOL Officers or the Courts for any Aboriginal to attend assessment for intervention programs, as set out in the Intervention Orders Act 2009.

There exists evidence that SAPOL have been issuing the unlawful orders, with the knowledge of the Commissioner of Police.

SAPOL essentially hand them out like confetti as a matter of convenience, but these orders are used to separate children from their parents and visa versa, for life in as little as 12 minutes.

A viewing of the Commissioner Briefing Papers will prove such. The data associated with the Courts of the above communities will prove such.

SAPOL have essentially been creating a “SAPOL Stolen Generation”, and this is nothing but Domestic Violence and Family Violence being predicated upon Aboriginals by SAPOL Officers.

I ask for the opportunity to present evidence using Magistrate Court Case Lists and the SAPOL General Orders-Intervention Orders, to the Commission to prove such is occurring South Australia, since 2011.
